Parking is to be in the back yard or on the side of the house (**minimum 10' from the front corner of the house if parked on the side**). **Driveway parking in front of garage is prohibited for long term parking/storage.**

Permits do not transfer with change or ownership, change of vehicle/trailer, or change of location on the property (any changes require a new permit).

Draw planned vehicle/RV/boat/camper/trailer location in relation to the house to include streets and driveways on the back of this application (or submit attachment). Please note all property lines and the distances the vehicle/RV/boat/camper/trailer will be from property lines, streets, and houses etc.

Violations of this permit may result in its revocation, suspension of all HBTS facility privileges and/or legal action.
